## Mill Woods Ladies Club Championship Guidelines

## ALL Members who enter the Club Championship MUST read these guidelines.

- Green fees must be paid at the Pro Shop BEFORE play.
- Each entrant must have a valid handicap.
  - Each entrant must have played a minimum of three 18-hole games (or the equivalent) during the current season at Mill Woods.
  - All games entered in the computer must have been played on RCGA rated courses for ladies, either from the white (middle) or red (forward) tees.
- E E hentrant will be assigned a flight according to her handicap.
  - The number of flights will be determined, as equally as possible, by the number of entrants.
- The flights and tee times for Saturday will be posted the preceding Monday. Sunday tee times will be determined after the first day of play and will be posted.
  - You **may not change** your tee time without the approval of a member of the tournament committee, club captain, or assistant club captain (Rule 6.3 and 6.3b).
- Each player must check in with the Starter prior to her tee time on each day to receive her official scorecard.
- Exchange your scorecard with another member of your group in a rotating manner (e.g., 1 gives to 2, 2 gives to 3, 3 gives to 4, and 4 gives to 1).
  - Keep a group scorecard as well as keeping your own score in case of discrepancies.
- Tournament scores will be based on 36 holes of stroke play.
  - Every stroke MUST be counted (no gimmes or mulligans allowed).
  - "Whiffs" or missed strokes count (unless they occur on the tee box and only then).
  - All rules of golf apply.
- \* Keep up the pace of play. If your group falls behind, please do the following:
  - As soon as **TWO PLAYERS** have finished putting, these two golfers should proceed to the next tee box and tee off while the other two golfers finish putting.
- Upon completion of each hole, announce your score to the group.
  - If you and the scorer do not agree on your score, **stop** and together count back the strokes taken.
  - If you still disagree, consult with the other members of your group. If you still do not agree, bring it to the attention of the official scorer and/or Club Captain before signing the scorecard.
  - It is your responsibility to ensure the person whose score you are keeping plays by the rules of golf and reports the correct score on every hole.
- BEFORE handing in your scorecard, ensure that the scorer and you, the attester, sign it and date it. An incorrect score or an unsigned scorecard will result in DISQUALIFICATION.
- Gross and net scores will be calculated to determine winners of each flight. There will also be an overall low gross and overall low net winner. All winners will be announced, and prizes awarded following the second round.
- In the event of a tie:
  - Club Champion gross score ties: The winner will be determined by a hole-by-hole play-off.
  - Flight gross score ties will be broken by a count back (i.e., last 9 holes, last 7 holes, last 3 holes, last hole).
  - Net score ties will be broken by a count back (i.e., last 9 holes minus ½ handicap, last 6 holes minus 1/3 handicap, last 3 holes minus 1/6 handicap, last hole minus 1/18 handicap).
